Notre Dame Preparatory High School Homecoming Dress Code

Semi-Formal Dress:

<u>Girls</u>

- Dresses must worn at the knee or longer.
- Two-piece dresses may not be worn.
- No bare midriffs may be seen at all.
- High low dresses must be below the knee in the front.
- Any dress with a sheer overlay must have an underskirt that goes below the knee.
- A dress with straps, or a strapless dress is appropriate, provided there is a modest neckline and there is no cleavage showing.
- No low-cut bodices; backless dresses must be at least waist-high.
- No side cut-outs allowed on dresses.
- No see-through dresses
- Dress shoes or cowboys boots are allowed.

<u>Guys</u>

- Gentlemen are required to wear a long sleeve, button-up, collared shirt with a bola tie, necktie, or bow tie.
- Dinner jacket/blazer/sport coat is required.
- Pants can be jeans or dress pants.
- Belt must be worn. Large belt buckle with appropriate messaging is encouraged.
- Cowboy hats are encouraged.
- Sneakers and cowboy boots are permitted.
- Shirts should remain tucked in for the duration of the dance.

Note for all students and guests in attendance:

- Visible tattoos and body piercings are not permitted at school or schoolsponsored events.
- The dress code applies to all students and guests of Notre Dame Preparatory.

The Administration reserves the right to make the final decision on the dress code. Students not properly attired may be asked to change and may not be permitted to enter the dance.
