Important Information:

- All classes capped at 24 students. Please email rhiskey@ndpsaints.org or call 480-634-8238 to be placed on a waiting list.
- All students must wear masks and have their temperature taken when they arrive on campus.
- All students will be given a break/lunch from 10:45 until 11:15.
- The cafeteria will be open for students to purchase snacks during lunch.
- No textbooks need to be purchased for any of the summer classes.
- Students are required to be in uniform with NDP polo, plain white polo, or NDP spirit t-shirt with uniform bottoms.
- Due to the abbreviated nature of the summer school session, it is essential that students are in classes each day to earn credit for their courses.

For all families, new and returning, please note the attendance policy: Arizona State Law & NDP Student/Parent Handbook requires that students are present for 90% of the summer course to receive credit. For year-long courses, students may miss no more than two class days (or a total of 11 hours) to earn credit. For semester-long courses, students may miss no more than one class day (or total of 5.5 hours) to earn credit. Due to the short and intensive nature of summer term, class attendance is absolutely critical, so please schedule doctor's appointments/family gatherings/vacations outside of the summer school session. All pre-arranged absences must be approved by administration.
