The surrounding community is comprised of residents primarily from business, managerial and professional occupations. We have 89 certified faculty and professional staff, including 4 religious educators. More than 60% of our faculty have master's degrees and 7.5% have their Ph.D. degrees.

Notre Dame Prep does not publish class rank. Grade point average is based on all courses taken at Notre Dame Preparatory.

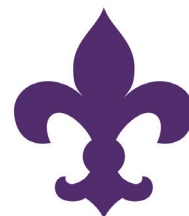
